Brother Fleenoil Lane, Jr., is a native of Durham, North Carolina. He is the only son of the late Fleenoil Lane, Sr. and the late Hattie Stephenson Lane. After graduating from Hillside High School, he attended Howard University School of Business with a concentration in finance and banking. He then spent the next eight years in New York City working with Manufactures Hanover Trust. He has the distinction of being the first recruit from a Historically Black College and University to be selected for the Management Operations Program. After leaving New York, he worked in numerous management capacities with several Fortune 500 companies in different East Coast cities.

Brother Lane returned to Durham in 1992 and enrolled in the North Carolina Central University School of Law while working with the North Carolina Department of Human Resources. He later accepted a management position with MCI (Verizon Business) in 1997. In 2006, Brother Lane joined NetApp Inc's management team and currently holds the position of Senior Manager for the Critical Case Program, leading a team of managers who represent the company during times of technical crises.

Brother Lane served as secretary for Beta Phi's Spring 2009 line, "Eleven Sons of Anarchy," and was initiated into the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity on June 27, 2009. Since his initiation, he has served the Fraternity as a member of the Achievement Week, Scholarship, and Mardi Gras committees. He exemplifies his dedication to serving others by participating in the Triangle Big Brothers Program mentoring Jamison, an eleven-year-old young man.
