John David Harrell, III

Mr. John David Harrell, III. a native of Durham, N.C. was the son of Fannie Johnson Harrell and the late John D. Harrell, Jr. He departed this life on Monday, June 30, 2008, at INOVA Fairfax Hospital, Falls Church, Virginia.

John was educated in the Durham Public School System. He completed his early education at Fayetteville Street Elementary School, James E. Shepard Junior High School and Hillside High School. He finished Hillside High School in the class of 1975. In the fall of 1975 he began his college education at North Carolina Central University (NCCU), majoring in Mathematics. While attending NCCU, John played one season with the Eagles Basketball team and was the leading scorer, averaging 19.3 points per game. While at North Carolina Central University, John received several awards including the distinction of being the only freshman on the MEAC all conference team. In 1977 John transferred to Duke University and became a member of the Blue Devil Basketball team. John was a point guard for the Duke Blue Devils and played from 1977-1979. In 1978 John played on the Blue Devil NCAA Championship team. His last minute free throws helped the Duke team to bring home the final four victory over Notre Dame. John graduated from Duke University with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Mathematics in 1981.

John started his working career at N.C. Mutual Life Insurance Company in Durham as an Actuarial Analyst. In 1982 John moved to the Northern Virginia area to pursue his career in software development. He then spent the next twenty-six years managing IT projects and systems development and providing systems analysis and testing in both the telecom and government sectors.

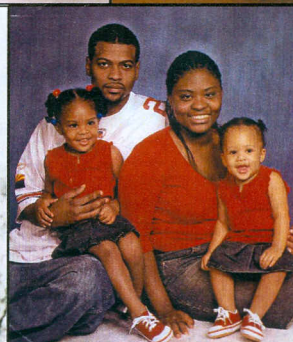
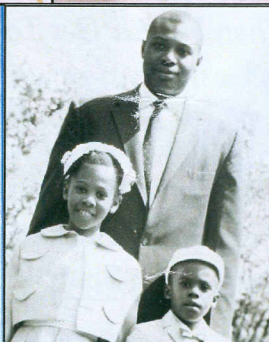
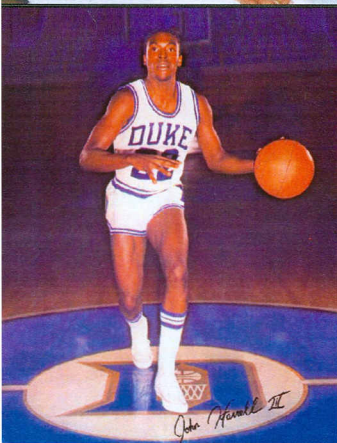
He was baptized at an early age at White Rock Baptist Church and remained a member until his death. He served as a junior usher, sang in the Junior Choir, Vacation Bible School recreation ministry, and was a proud member of J.W. Carrington's Sunday School Class.

He was also a writer, having written several volumes of poetry and was in the process of completing his first book entitled, *Running and Being Love, Living the Runner's High*. 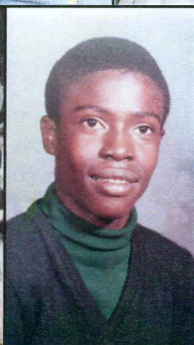
When I Must Leave You
